The Georgia Health Care Association Education & Research Foundation's mission is to promote professional development through education and to attract nurses to long term and post-acute care. Established in 1991, the nursing scholarship program was created to financially assist nurses to obtain or advance their education and to encourage specialization in long term and post-acute care. The program is funded by contributions to and participation in the annual Scholarship Golf Tournament and other donations received throughout the year.

Greater than 300 scholarships have been awarded over the years resulting in clinically competent and dedicated nurses at the bedside of those entrusted to our care. Scholarships are awarded annually and are available to LPN and RN students. In addition to tuition scholarships, nurses who successfully graduate, pass nursing boards and remain employed in a skilled nursing center, are eligible for a bonus.
